CONTACT LENS DEPARTMENT INFORMATION

We know the reason our patients come to Consulting Ophthalmologists, P.C. is to obtain the best vision possible. Every day we strive to meet this goal with compassion and skill. We employ the newest technology and prescribe the latest in contact lens materials in order to provide optimal vision and eye health. We work closely with our patients to ensure that they are comfortable in their contact lenses, and are happy and well informed when they leave our office.

In order to obtain a valid prescription for contact lenses, a contact lens evaluation or fitting must be performed. If you currently wear contact lenses, please bring your contact lens prescription or a contact lens box with you.

If you have insurance coverage for contact lens fittings and lenses, please contact your insurance company to determine what they will cover and confirm our office participates with your plan.

FITTING FEES

- Contact lens fitting services are separate from eye examinations and there is a separate fee. <u>This fee</u> is due on the day of the fitting.
- At their annual contact lens check, current contact lens wearers will be charged anywhere from \$60 to \$90 depending on the prescription. The fee for patients who have either never worn contact lenses or are having a fit by COPC for the first time, ranges from \$160 to \$250 depending on the type of lens prescribed (soft, toric, multifocal, rigid gas-permeable). Two additional follow-up visits (if needed) are included in this fee.
- Previous contact lens wearers: Fees range from \$80 to \$200, depending on the type of lens. One additional visit is included in this fee.
- If a fit is initiated but not completed there is a charge of \$40 for time spent.
- Fees for specialized contact lens fittings for keratoconus, corneal disease and post-surgical correction including corneal transplant range from \$250-\$1300 for new contact lens wearers and \$200-\$1250 for previous contact lens wearers.

CONTACT LENS FEES

- Contact lenses may be ordered on line at www.consultingeye.com for your convenience.
- All contact lenses sold at COPC are priced competitively with online outlets and local discount merchants.
- Contact lenses must be paid for in full at the time of dispensing.
- Lenses in the original, unmarked and unopened package can be returned for a full refund within 90 days of the order date.

CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTIONS

A written copy of your prescription will be provided once the fitting process is complete and your fitter is confident of your continued eye health while wearing lenses. Contact lens prescriptions are valid for one year in the state of Connecticut.
